

Summary Recommendations

- 1) Get the ICSP and GDS working on low impact development which reduces the amount of stormwater runoff. Educate all, including planting native trees, ordering rain barrels for spring.
- 2) That you delay changing Storm Management Fees until you have had a chance to look at best practices, such as Philadelphia's, for green development which can be adapted to smaller communities like Cobourg. Then, you can implement green incentives to lower taxes. Get the green infrastructure grant and use King St. W sewers as a pilot, as did Kitchener.
- 3) The Council needs to champion this cause, along with town management to create goals and incentives for citizens, businesses and employees of the town. Will this Council step up to be champion of ICSP and GDS?
