# **Councillor Silent as CTA Ejected**

Brian Darling didn't say a word as staff ejected Bryan Lambert, Lydia Smith, Ken Strauss and Ted Williams from a secret Parks and Recreation Steering Committee meeting on May 4, 2018. Both provincial legislation and Cobourg's own bylaws require that the town's committee meetings must be open to the public and have published agendas and minutes. In spite of numerous requests, the Cobourg Taxpayers Association (CTA) has been unable to obtain any agendas, any minutes, or any meeting information for this committee. The Town claims the committee was set up to provide, "input and advice to the Director of Recreation and Culture". In response to the CTA's requests for information, Parks Director, Dean Hustwick, has replied to the CTA's requests by saying, "I have not made a decision yet about whether the minutes from the Steering Committee meetings will be made public.". Huh?
