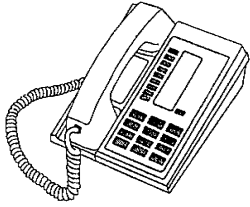

2019 TAX INFORMATION



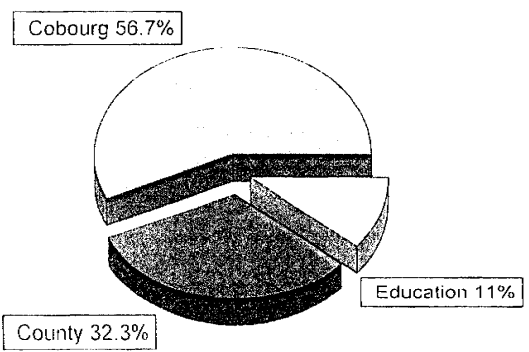
For residential taxpayers in Cobourg, this year's tax rate of .0083059 represents a slight decrease from the 2018 tax rate.

The impact of this decrease coupled with an average 1.19% assessment increase is set out below. There is also a comparison of your 2019 and 2018 tax bills on Schedule 2 of your bill.

Where do my Municipal Tax dollars go?

The Municipal portion of the average \$3,909 tax bill is \$2,217 or 56.7% of the bill. This represents a monthly charge of \$184.75.

Illegal Dumping

Report illegal dumpers of garbage to the County of Northumberland toll-free hotline at 1-866-293-8379 and give the location, the type of materials that were dumped, and any other information you have regarding the incident. In all cases, the more information you have, the better chance of us catching the culprit! A license plate number and description of the person and vehicle helps tremendously. A reminder to never open bagged garbage in search of evidence - leave this for our by-law officers.

Household Hazardous Waste

Bring old paint, aerosols, diabetic insulin needles, pesticides, batteries, oil, fluorescent tubes and more to one of our four Household Hazardous Waste Depots in Northumberland County. The Cobourg Depot will be open from 8:30 a.m. - 2:00 p.m. on the following dates:

- May 1, 2 and 4
- June 5 and 8
- July 3 and 6
- August 7 and 10
- September 4 and 7
- October 2 and 5

Please no empty paint cans or containers. To find out what else you can bring to a depot or for information about additional locations and dates, please refer to your 2019 Waste & Recycling calendar, visit www.northumberland.ca or call 1-866-293-8379. Take Advantage of the **Electronics Drop-Off** at the Depots as well - TVs, computers, monitors, cell phones, VCRs and more can be brought free of charge when the Depot is open.
